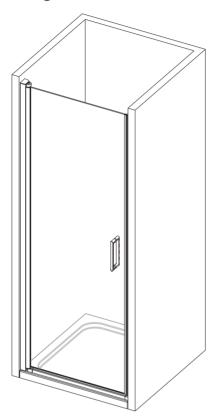
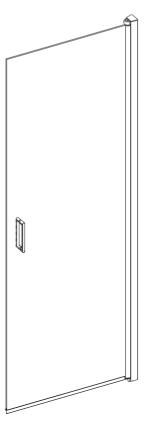

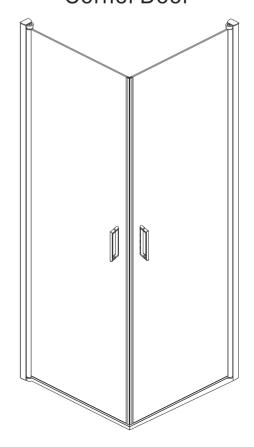

## **IMPORTANT:**

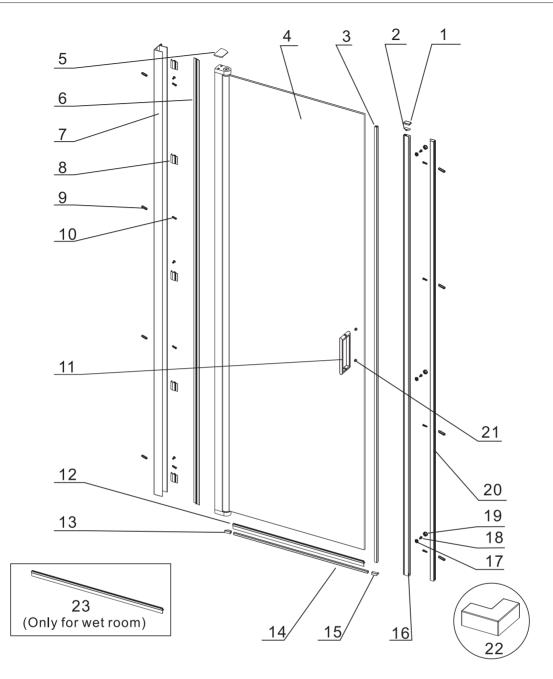
Please read the complete instructions before commencing fitting.

Do not attempt to install the product unless you can tick all 4 boxes satisfactorily.

•	Check that you have the tools required	
•	Check the installation site is compatible with	
	the sizes of door supplied	
•	Check all the enclosure components are present	
•	Check the installation kit is complete	

The wall plugs supplied with the installation kit are for use in solid walls. Hollow or 'stud partition' walls will require alternative fixings. Please consult a hardware supplier for the correct type. It may also be necessary to consult your tiling supplier about the correct method for drilling your tiles.

ATTENTION: TAKE EXTREME CARE WHEN HANDLING GLASS, WEAR PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR AND CLOTHING. DO NOT LEAVE THE GLASS ON HARD SURFACES AND AVOID CONTACT BETWEEN THE GLASS EDGES AND HARD SURFACES OR IMPACTS DURING THE INSTALLATION.



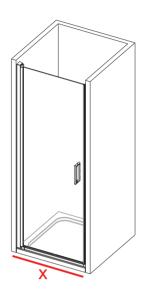

## Adjustment when used as Pivot door in a recess

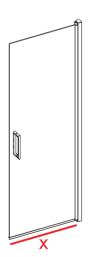

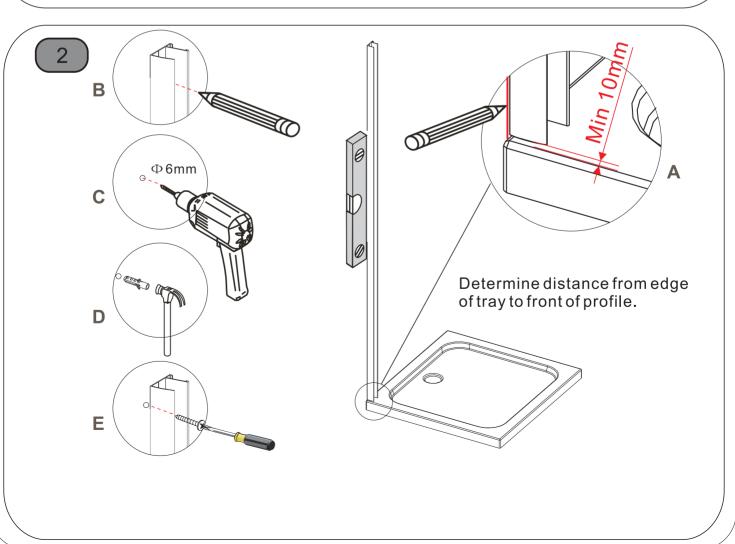
NOTE: When the door is in a corner door situation you can use it with the lunar rail or without the lunar rail (longer fin seal supplied)





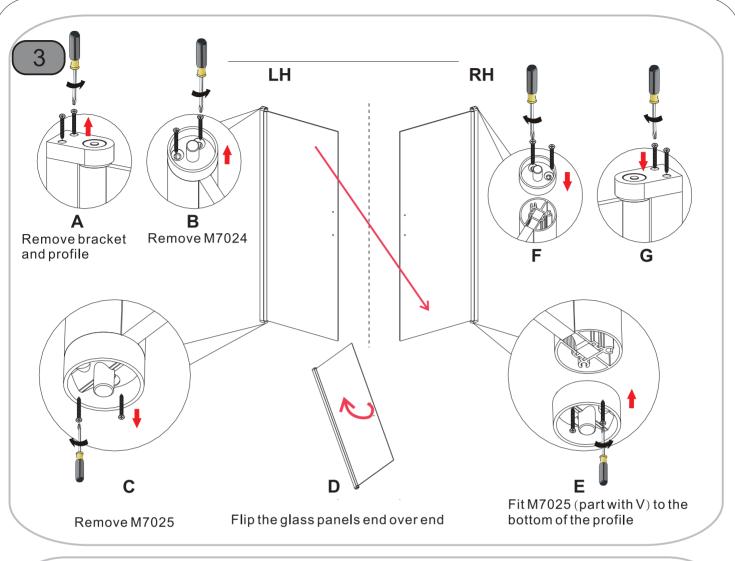


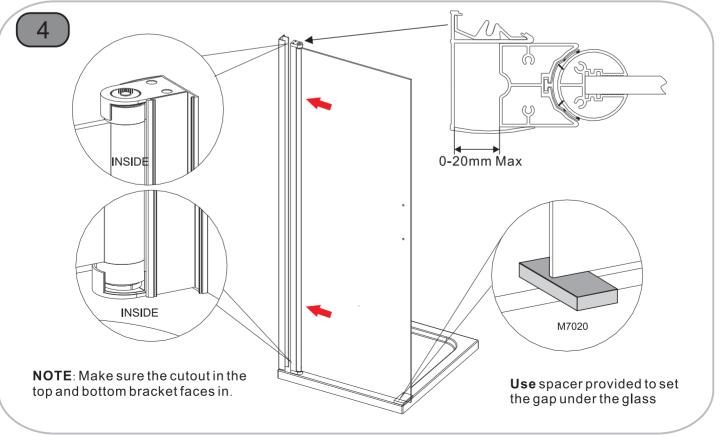


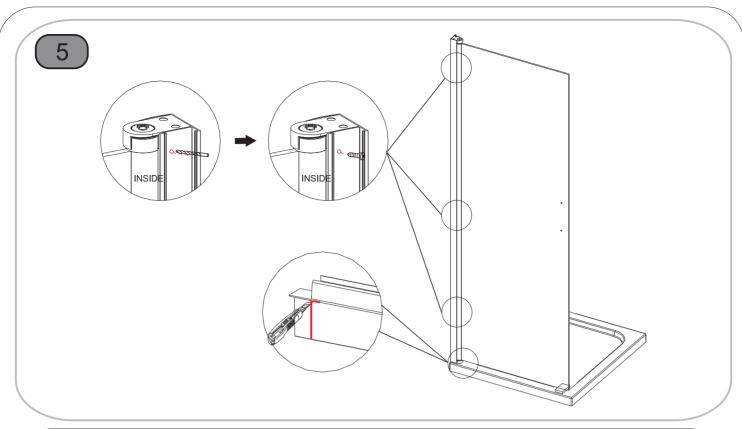


The door is set up as a left hand unit for a right hand door the M7024&M7025 brackets must be swapped from top to bottom to allow for a left and right hand product.

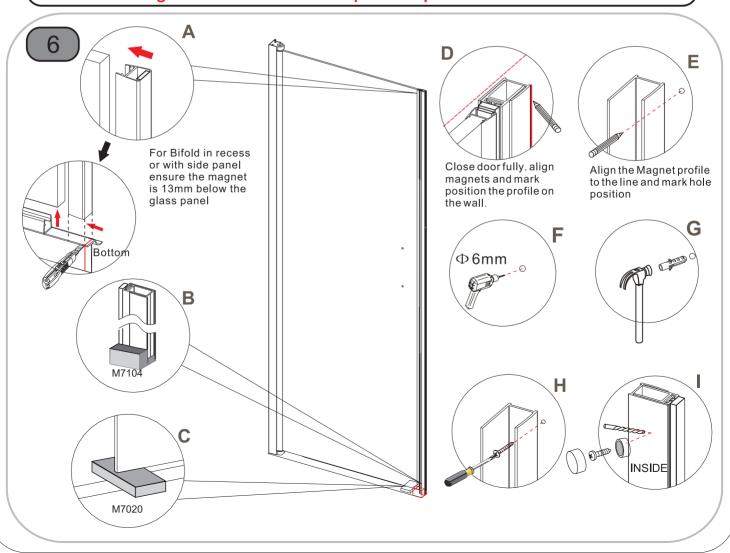
NOTE: M7025 with the V shape should always be on the bottom.

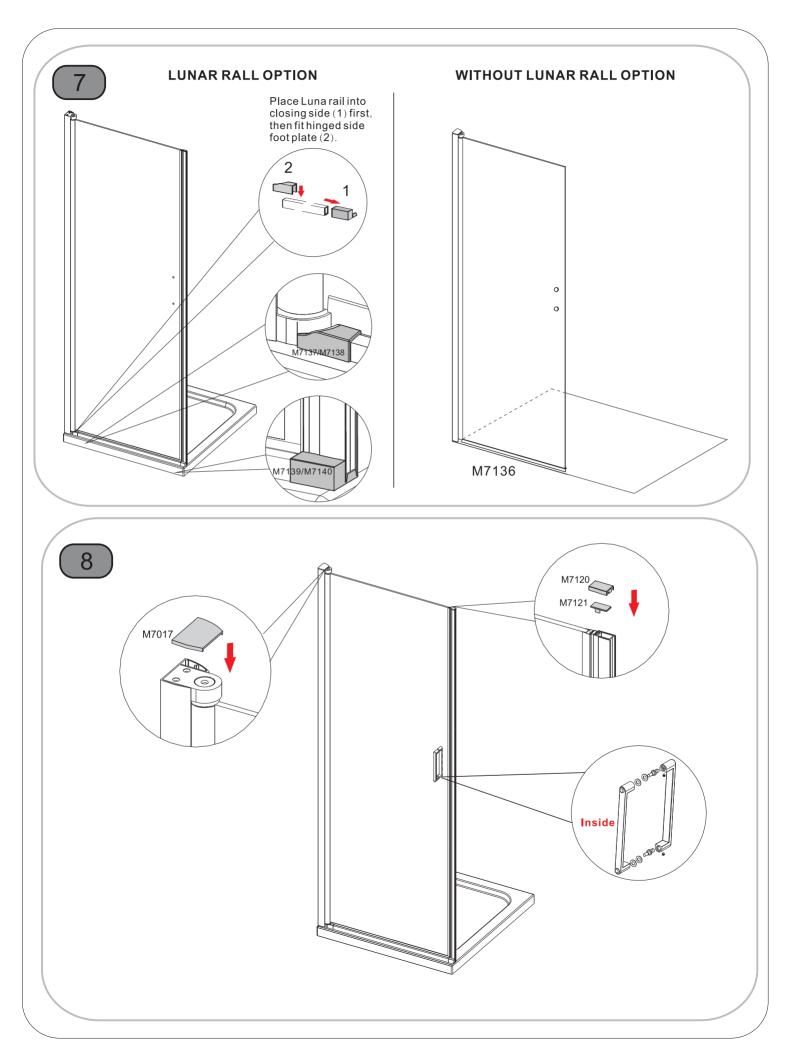


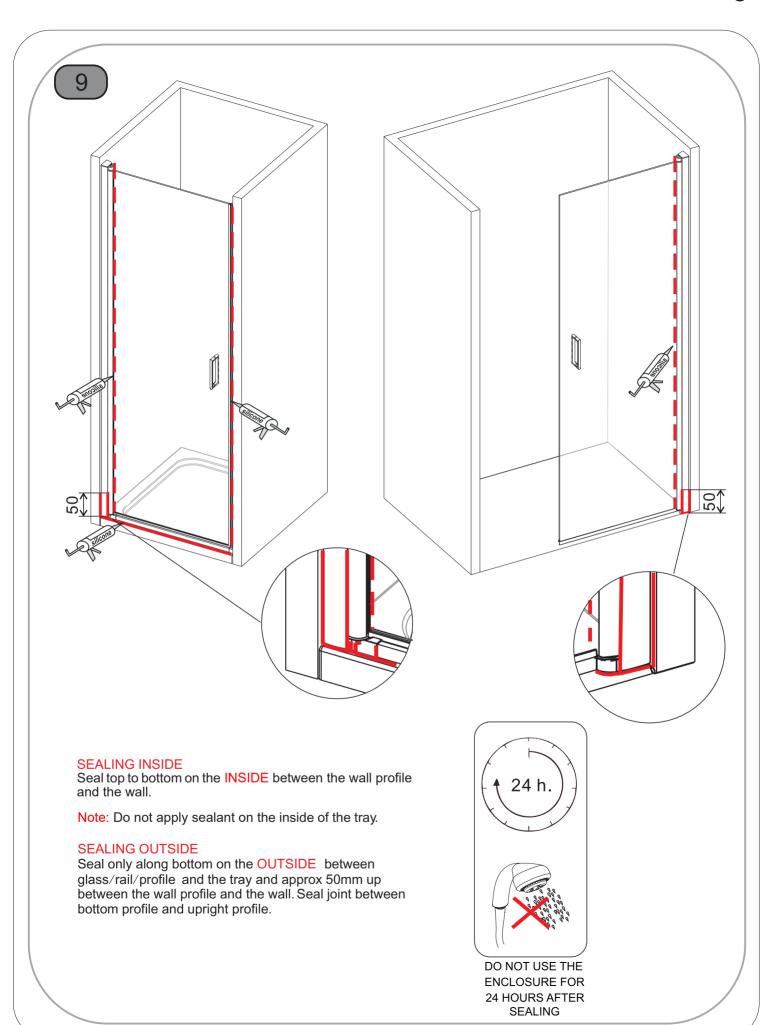


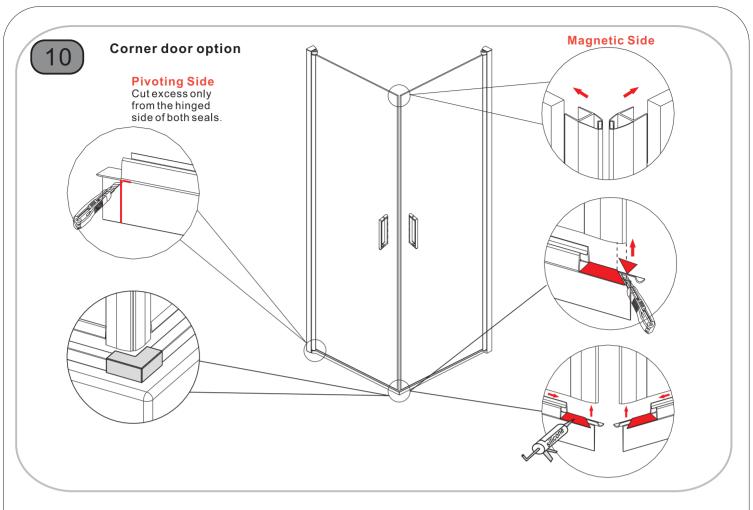


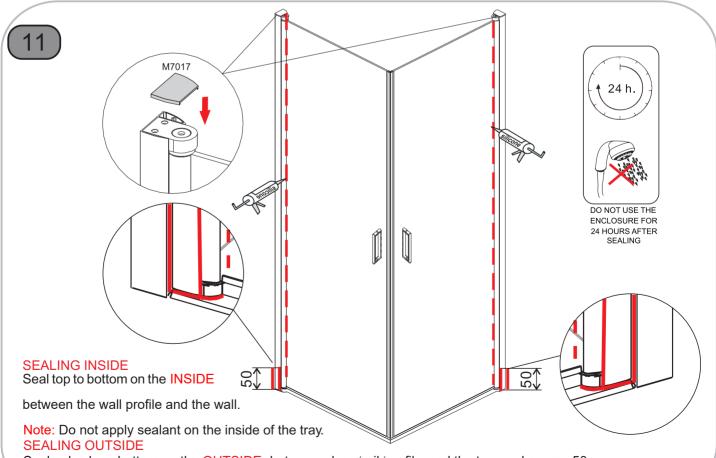
Note: If fitting as a shower wall skip to step 09 for sealing instructions. If fitting as a corner door skip to step 10.











Seal only along bottom on the OUTSIDE between glass/rail/profile and the tray and approx 50mm up between the wall profile and the wall. Seal joint between bottom profile and upright profile.

#### **CLEANING**

It is important to clean your Merlyn shower door after every use. Wipe down all the glass and metal parts with a soft cloth. Do not allow lime scale to build up in hard water areas. Ensure that any residual water on the glass is removed after every use.

- ? Clean the glass regularly using soapy water.
- ? Do not use abrasive products on any surfaces.

Chrome is vulnerable to acid attack and some strong household cleaners including strong disinfectants, denture cleaners, hair dyes, wine making chemicals and photographic chemicals may contain acid. These materials may have a varying effect on the surface from black spots/streaks (which cannot be removed) to pitting the surface. Contact with these materials should be avoided.

### **TROUBLE SHOOTING**

#### **Door Not Aligning**

- 1. Is the tray 100% level? (see page 5)
- 2. Have the walls been checked at different levels to ensure consistency? Bumps or hollows in the wall may push the frame out of alignment.
- 3. Are the wall profiles stepped in a Min. 10mm from the edge of the tray? ( see page 6)
- 4. Do the finished tile measurements at top, middle and bottom fall within the adjustment (X) listed on step 2.

### **Door Leaking**

- 1. Is the door sealed correctly? (see step 11)
- 2. Check to ensure the door frame is 100% square.
